Guidelines of a CommUnity Group:

- Meet year round with no designated stopping point
 - We will have the freedom to take short breaks when needed (i.e. Summer vacations, Holidays)
 - o It is recommended and encouraged to meet weekly
 - o Meet on a day of the week decided by each group individually
- Have 8-12 members
 - o A concise group that allows for openness and intimacy through interpersonal relationships.
- Provide childcare for the children of the group (See childcare guidelines)
- Plan an opportunity to serve at least once a quarter as a group
 - o This can take the place of a weekly meeting time for a given week
- Strive to keep a vision of multiplication among the group members.
 - Our goal is to multiply and grow these groups as Stanwood grows. This multiplication will bring the need for new leaders from within. The need for splitting a group and planting afresh is a goal.

Member Expectations:

As a member of this group, I will commit to the following values:

Participation

I will make the group meeting a priority and will notify the leader if I will be absent.

I will spend time weekly preparing for the group lesson.

I will participate in the group discussion on a regular basis.

I will pray about how God wants to use my gifts in this group.

Caring

I will keep confidential information within the group.

I will be sensitive about offering advice during group discussion and prayer time.

I will provide care, encouragement, and prayer for those in the group.

Spiritual Authority

I recognize this group is a ministry of Stanwood Community Church.

As an SCC group, I realize the group is under the authority of the church and it's Elder Leadership.

I recognize that the group leader is responsible for the direction of the group.

Growing

I recognize the relational bonds formed in this group will help me to grow spiritually.

I will let the group leader know if/when I've asked someone else to join the group (Gives opportunity to prepare)

I will keep the vision of multiplication in mind and realize that my group may be called on to plant new relationships when the time comes.

Fellowship

I will interact with this group with openness to developing relationship.

Outreach

I will do my best to participate in service opportunities, in conjunction with the church or as decided by the group

Community Group Childcare

Teenage girls may be used as childcare providers. Teenage boys should only be used if another female is also responsible for the care of the children. No teenage boys should be authorized to care for children alone. Teens under the age of 14 should not be the primary (1st) caregivers for the children.

The caregiver's main responsibility is the safety of the children. She may provide a planned "lesson" time for the children, but this is not required. Children's activities, including television or video viewing, must be compatible with our Christian beliefs and morality standards.

Parents' Responsibilities

Infants may remain with their parents in the group, but all mobile children are encouraged to be with the caregiver in the childcare room. Children may be included in prayer, social and outreach times when deemed appropriate by the group leader.

Parents are encouraged to make sure their child(ren) have diapering and toileting needs met before leaving them with the childcare provider. If the childcare provider is not able to supervise the other children in the group then a parent may be called upon for assistance.

Please do not bring children who are ill with fever, diarrhea, vomiting, eye redness/seepage, or nose drainage other than clear or have had these symptoms within the past 24 hours. Parents should give childcare providers any necessary special instructions for their children.

Childcare Payment

To ensure that no unnecessary burden is placed on an individual, Stanwood will be paying our Childcare providers \$10 an hour. Funds can be given to supplement these funds if desired, but it is not required. If you desire to give, please give on Sunday morning in the offering and mark 'Community Group babysitting.'
